

Jesus is Alive!

Tissue Flowers

Celebrate new life and that Jesus is alive with these colorful flowers!



1. Stack 3 pieces of tissue paper and fold into quarters.
2. Draw petal shapes along the two edges without the fold. Cut out shapes, and unfold.
3. Bend one end of a pipe cleaner to form a round nub. Use the other end to pierce a hole in the center of the tissue and pull it through to form a stem.
4. At the flower base, scrunch the petals closed. Wrap floral tape around the scrunched tissue and down the stem. The tape gets sticky as you stretch it.
5. Cut out a leaf and slide onto the stem.
