Make a Long-Winded Pinwheel!

- 1. Print on regular weight paper. If you want, you can mount another color of paper to the back.
- 2. Cut out around the square, then on the dotted lines.
- 3. Without creasing, fold the corners marked with a dot to the center, overlapping the points.
- 4. Push a pin through all four points and the back, and stick into the eraser of a pencil.
- 5. Wait for some wind, or give your pinwheel some assistance with old fashioned hot air!
