

Make a Long-Winded Pinwheel!

1. Print on regular weight paper. If you want, you can mount another color of paper to the back.
2. Cut out around the square, then on the dotted lines.
3. Without creasing, fold the corners marked with a dot to the center, overlapping the points.
4. Push a pin through all four points and the back, and stick into the eraser of a pencil.
5. Wait for some wind, or give your pinwheel some assistance with old fashioned hot air!
