## Measurable Bracelet

This embellished bracelet shows off your love of sewing, and it's functional!



### Here's what you'll need:

Cloth measuring tape  
Embroidery thread  
Button

### Here's what you'll do:

Decide how long your bracelet will be. I made mine to wrap around my wrist 3 times, so it is about 20" long. Cut your measuring tape.



Stitch some fun details onto your measuring tape. I stitched starbursts, circles, traced some numbers, and added a running stitch to the entire length.



Sew a button to one end of the bracelet.





Fold over the other end of the bracelet and stitch it down, creating a loop in the measuring tape.

Through that loop, create a loop of embroidery floss that your button will fit through. Secure the thread well.



Wrap around your wrist, and fasten the button. Wear with pride!
