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Favorite Yarn Headband

Grab your favorite yarn, and knit it as you like it!



Here's what you'll need:

Yarn (I used vintage...I think worsted weight)
Knitting needles (I used US 5)
Crochet hook (I used H/8)
Large tapestry needle



Here's what you'll do:

Cast on 9 stitches.

Row 1: K2, P2, K1, P2, K2

Row 2: K2, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 3: K3, P3, K3

Row 4: K2, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K2

Row 5: K2, P2, K1, P2, K2

Row 6: K2, P5, K2

Repeat rows 1-6 until you reach your desired length, about 15". Cast off.



Cut six pieces of yarn, each 36".



Fold a piece of cut yarn in half, then using your crochet hook, pull the loop end through a stitch at the end of your headband.



Pull the loose ends through the loop. Repeat so you have three evenly spaced ties at each end of your headband.



At each end, loosely braid the three strands, and tie a knot at the ends.



Use the braids to tie on your headband!

Other ideas:

- Try bulky yarn and larger needles.
- Create your own pattern of stitches.
- Add embellishments, like buttons, beads or felt cut outs to your finished headband.
