## Felt Pumpkin Needle Book

Don't get stuck with missing needles...keep them in this little pumpkin!



### Here's what you'll need:

Felt in two colors (I used eco-felt)  
Embroidery floss  
Patterns (on last page)



### Here's what you'll do:

Cut out two pumpkins with stems and two without. Stack them with the smaller, non-stem pumpkins in the middle.



On the left edge, stitch all four layers together using a running stitch. Tie a knot to secure it, but don't cut your thread yet.



Continue the running stitch around the top pumpkin, but be sure not to catch any of the other layers.



When you get back to the binding edge, tie a knot to secure the thread, but again...don't cut your thread. Stitch down through all the layers so you're ready to stitch around the back pumpkin.



Stitch around the back pumpkin and when you return to the binding edge, tie a knot.



Fill with your needles, and you're all set for more fun fall crafting!
