### **Button Buddies Emboidery**

Use a button as the base for your embroidery...use it to embellish anything!



### Here's what you'll need:

Fabric (or something to embroider on) Embroidery floss 1" Button Pattern from page 3



## Here's what you'll do:

Trace your pattern onto your fabric. Don't trace the button...it's just there to show you the placement. But guess what? You could stitch the button instead of using a real one...that would be cute too!



Stitch your design. Because this is pretty small, you may want to only use a few strands of floss. I used three throughout the hedgehog.





Sew a button in the middle of your design, and you're all finished!


You can use your finished embroidery for all kinds of things. Make all of them and hang them as a grouping. Embellish some clothing. Get creative!







